Director notes: There came a point at every rehearsal, when the weight of this show would settle on my shoulders and I would have to stop myself from sobbing.

These are real words. Written by real children. Who were really murdered. Let that sink in.

As a historical event the Holocaust stands out for its vastness but certainly not in its expression of evil. History is full of evil. The present is full of evil. We look at these events and wonder "How can people do these things?" Is there a spark of evil in all of us? Are we all just one word or one event away from stripping others of their humanity and turning on them?

What I hope for my students, and for you, is that you will let the lives of the Terezin children be an example of how to survive through humanity's worst darkness: keep looking for beauty, keep reaching for love and keep fighting against fear and hatred. Let that be a small light of victory.

For the cast and crew, you are amazing. I am so very proud of all of you for taking on this project and for treating it with the respect it deserves.

Thank you *Elisabeth and Rebecca* for being the best possible partners throughout this process. For your creative input, humour and encouragement. MYT will keep you forever if you allow it. Thank you *Dima, Jen, Laura, Sharon, Julia and Jackson* for all your work with the students. Thank you *Fiona, Mia and Bea* for being amazing. Thank you *HERC* for sharing your time, your wisdom, your faith in our production to tell the truth about a history we must never forget.

Assistant Director notes: As a child, I was privileged to hear the poems and writing of children of the Terezin concentration camp through my local choir. Their stories, pictures, and poems have stuck with me since. Through the shows I Never Saw Another Butterfly and The Terezin Promise we are offered a unique point of view, through the hopes, dreams, and pain of the young artists themselves. We feel the fear and determination through their actions, bravery, and strength. Raja is one of the very few survivors of the camp. Out of the 15,000 children, all under the age of 15 years old, who passed through Terezin, only 100 survived to see the end of the war. The newspaper we discussed was a real paper written by the boys of Terezin. Only one writer is known to have survived to see the end of the war.




