- **Cost:** \$500* or \$800* for two performances on the same day in the same space
 - Morning or afternoon performances available
- **Audience:** Maximum audience size is 250
- **Length:** Approximately 70 minutes, including a 10-minute, guided question and answer session after the show
- **Cast and Crew:** 20+ Milwaukee students ranging in age from 10-18
- **Space Requirements:** Most any size room. We bring all sound and light equipment with us. *A power source is required.*
- **In-Classroom, Pre-Show Workshops:** An additional fee of \$50 per classroom. Each workshop is 1 hour and led by an MYT staff member.
- **Study Guides:** Our free guides offer suggestions for activities and discussions that meet classroom learning goals.
